



Full-Time EMT

Job Description

Edgecombe County EMS is accepting applications for full-time EMTs. These personnel are responsible for staffing ambulances and responding to / caring for the citizens and visitors of Edgecombe County. There are various shift schedules dependent upon which division of EMS that is assigned.

- **911 Division Schedule**
 - **24/72 Shift Schedule**: meaning that the duration of a duty shift is 24 hours followed by 72 hours of “off duty” time. Report time is by 6:45am to 7:00am the following day.
- **Transport Division**
 - There are various shift schedules and flexibility with this division. 8-hour shifts, 13-hour shifts, etc. If you have further questions about the shift schedules that are available, please contact Karla Braddy (Transport Supervisor) at karlabraddy@edgecombeco.com.

Essential Functions

- Respond to both emergency and non-emergency calls for service
- Foster and maintain professional relationships with other providers, healthcare workers, citizens, and patients
- Provide lifesaving measures to the critically ill or injured within the scope an EMT
- Facilitate transport of these patients to the hospital
- Check / maintain EMS equipment / medical supplies when on duty
- Complete patient care reports (PCRs) after a call for service
- Participate in training programs and other activities at the discretion of the EMS Coordinator

Education and Experience

- High school diploma or GED
- North Carolina AEMT state certification
- North Carolina Driver’s License and acceptable driving record

Salary Range

The salary range total is not including regularly scheduled overtime. On top of the starting salary, Edgecombe County offers excellent benefits that total over \$10,000 annually in addition to 2% contribution to the 401k.

- Emergency EMT: **\$14.93 – 17.91**/hr (Base Salary \$31,054.40 - 37,265.28)
- Transport EMT: **\$15.19 – 18.22**/hr (Base Salary \$31,595.20 - 37,914.24)
