LEPC Meeting:

Andy Oberle, Assistant Facility Manager with Post Rock, was introduced.

Keith Haberer will meet with the Ellsworth County Commissioners regarding who should receive Emergency Badges.

Nathan Florian, EMS Director, said that the Youth Safety Day that was held on April 26, 2023 for USD 327 6th graders went well. Nathan is also working on getting AEDs for all county buildings. He is working on a grant to purchase these AED's. EMS will now be responsible for printing the Emergency Card for personnel that need access to county facilities and/or equipment in case of an emergency. He is also going to purchase a barcode printer. These barcodes will be placed on all equipment that could be used in an emergency. The purpose of these barcodes is to track where equipment is and for reimbursement of used equipment during an emergency. Nathan is also working to locate all the AEDs in the county for an app that will track where an AED is located for the public in case it is needed in an emergency.

Ralph Doubrava, Ellsworth City Fire Chief, said that there was a Fire Chief's Meeting April 26, 2023. During the meeting Murray Marston, Ellsworth County Sheriff, gave an update on the purchase of new radios. Ralph said that Geneseo would be without a water tower for a couple of months. If there is an emergency, well water will have to be used during this time.
