| Local Concerns | It was noted that most offices in the courthouse have access to a vault for protection from an active shooter or tornado. A review is being done of all county entities for safe areas. Sheriff Maston noted that a 800MHz radio channel is to be added by the prison / DOC. Plans are underway to update all of the radios with new channels at the same time. Authorization has been provided to give the channel to nearby entities. Reminder given to be patient with any event requiring assistance from dispatch. (The dispatch center needs to be updated with additional consoles. One console is not sufficient.)
