November 27, 2017

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Oller called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the Agenda. Commissioner Oller seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

PUBLIC FORUM:

Anthony Hopkins, Kanopolis Citizen, discussed the issue of the dips that are becoming worse on Ohio Street. Ohio Street is a County road that runs through Kanopolis City and he wants to know if the County will fix this issue. The Commissioners said they would discuss the issue with the Road & Bridge Supervisor, Rick Nondorf.

APPOINTMENTS:

At the request of **Rod Rees, EMS Director**, Commissioner Rush made the motion to go into executive session to discuss non-elected personnel with County Clerk from 9:17 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. The topic is the retiring of an employee and the position that this will be opening. In regards to the Ohio Street dips in the City of Kanopolis, Mr. Nondorf said the correct solution would be to mill down the roads which is very costly. Commissioner Oller asked Mr. Nondorf to contact Mr. Hopkins to discuss the issue.
