MINUTES

February 25, 2019

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 25th day of February 2019 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

OPENING BUSINESS:

Chairman Dlabal called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Rush moved to approve the Agenda. Commissioner Rolfs seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

Commissioner Rolfs moved to approve the Minutes for February 19, 2019. Commissioner Rush seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.

PUBLIC FORUM:

Billy Kryger, Pastor of the Smoky Hill Baptist Church in Ellsworth, was in attendance but did not wish to address the Commissioners.

APPOINTMENTS:

Paul Kasper, County Attorney, informed the Commissioners that Security First Title submitted a bid of \$75.00 per parcel and a \$25.00 per parcel update charge. Smoky Hill Title Company did not provide a bid for the title insurance. Commissioners awarded the bid to Security First Title for Ellsworth County's Tax foreclosure for \$75.00 per parcel and \$25.00 per parcel update charge on approximately 50 parcels.

Teresa Shute, Noxious Weed Supervisor, requested Chairman Dlabal to sign her annual Noxious Weed Eradication Report.

Andrew Bair, ECMC CEO, discussed the recent State visit at ECMC. The State found a couple of minor infractions. Hospital staff missed a few items on the patient assessments. Procedures will be put in place to correct this problem.

Rick Nondorf, Road & Bridge, received a call from Tony Heitschmidt about a section of road on Ave X just north of Highway 4. Mr. Nondorf provided pictures of the washed out road from his cell phone. He said we constantly need to refill the road with sand and rock. He is considering building a 5 foot by 30 foot bridge to correct this issue. He will obtain their permission when he knows more.
