### MINUTES

**July 30, 2018**

The Board of Ellsworth County Commissioners convened this 30<sup>th</sup> day of July 2018 at the Ellsworth County Courthouse.

**OPENING BUSINESS:**

**APPOINTMENTS:**

**Teresa Shute, Noxious Weed**, addressed a complaint that the chemical Paraquat had been sprayed inside Ellsworth City limits. The City asked her to make recommendations on which chemicals could be used inside City limits. The Commissioners and Ms. Shute agreed that she will not make any recommendations due to the liability.

**Jeremiah Brown, EMS Director**, briefed the Commissioners on the Ambulance that was taken to Great Bend with a fuel issue. Mr. Brown expects to be able to pick it up in the next couple of days. A 1997 Blazer used as a first response vehicle is no longer running. He wanted the Commissioners opinions on the replacement. Mr. Brown will contact Kansas Surplus to try and find a replacement.

**Roger Masse, ECMC Administrator**, discussed his Administration report with Commissioners. Mr. Masse feels from a cash standpoint the Hospital is healthy. After the audit in November, the new administrator will be able to better determine how the Hospital is financially.
