___ Board of Review (Property Taxes)	As required (March, July & December)	Hear appeals on property assessments.
___ Cemetery Commission	Meet 3 rd Thursday of each month.	Oversee perpetual care of cemetery.
___ Downtown Development Authority (DDA)	Meet 2 nd Tuesday of each month.	Help halt property value deterioration and increase property tax valuation and promote economic growth in the business district.
___ Election Commission	Meet as needed.	Oversee and responsible for all activities and duties required by state law and city charter relating to conduct of all elections in the city.
___ Ewart Fire Board	Meet 2 nd Tuesday of each month.	Oversee the Area Fire Dept.
___ Historic District Commission	Meet quarterly.	Decide issues related to the enforcement of Historic District ordinance, etc.
___ Historic District Study Committee	Meet as needed.	Research proposed historic districts for the purpose of historic preservation within the city.
___ Housing Commission	Meet 3 rd Tuesday of each month.	Manages all public housing facilities and rental voucher (section 8) programs in the city.
___ Library Board	Meet monthly.	Help support the library's sustainability in the future and creating a responsive plan of action to the community's needs.
___ Local Compensation Committee (Pay Commission)	Meet at least once, but not more than fifteen times, in each odd-numbered year.	Determine the salaries of the City's elected officials.
___ Parks and Recreation	Meet 2 nd Tuesday of each month.	Recommend updates and improvements for city parks.

____ Planning Commission	Meet 4 th Monday of each month.	Charged with adoption and implementation of plans for the city. Also makes recommendations on amendments to planning and zoning code.
____ Zoning Board of Appeals	Meet as needed.	Considers requests for variances to planning and zoning code.
