All Evart residents can recycle curb side at no additional cost. Republic picks up recycling twice a month and provides as many bins as you need. Bins are available at Evart City Hall at the Depot and we encourage EVERYONE to participate. Republic accepts paper, cardboard, glass, metal, and a wide varieties of plastics. Please rinse out all containers as dirty products can contaminate an entire load. Check out their website at RepublicServices.com to see exactly what they do or do not accept. Some of the products NOT allowed are pill bottles, plastic grocery bags, styrofoam, wood, or yard waste. Recycling saves landfill space!

Low Income Household Water Assistance Program

The Michigan Department Of Health And Human Services (MDHHS) has opened a new program for people who are un-able to pay their water bill by the due date. Some requirements you must have to receive this include: be under 150% federal poverty limit and or receiving temporary assistance for needy families (TANF), Food Assistance program/ supplemental nutrition assistance program FAP/SNAP, SER, or Social Security Supplemental income (SSI).
