Trash and Recycle Updates

Our weekly residential trash pick-up will be changing during COVID-19. As of right now, Republic Services will not be picking up one (1) bulk item every week. This is to help prevent the spread of the virus.

Until further notice, Republic will only be taking six (6) bags every week. Please remember, bags cannot exceed 50 pounds, and everything MUST be bagged, or it will not be picked up.

Recycling service is suspended further notice. Please put your recycling with your normal weekly trash. All recycle centers have been shut down.

Leaf and Brush Pick-Up/Storm Drains

Leaf and brush pick-up is on hold at this time. Once things are able to go back to normal, we will be working to get the leaves and brush picked up as soon as we can. In the meantime, please keep your leaves and brush in your yard, do not put them to the street. No cemetery brush permits will be issued at this time.

When the leaves are on the street and it rains, the rain will wash the leaves into the storm drains, this will cause the storm drains to clog.

Important Reminder...

Please be respectful of social distancing.

Our administrative staff is all working from home, however, our Department of Public Works and Water/Wastewater staff are not. They are essential and extremely important to the city's infrastructure. So if you see them, please do not approach them, be respectful of social distancing, they won't think you're being rude, they will thank you.

Late Fees and Penalties will be waived

All late fees and penalties for the monthly utility billing (water/sewer/trash) will be waived at this time. We are encouraging residents to stay home as much as possible to help keep everyone safe and healthy.

Monthly payments made online, through the mail or in our two (2) drop box locations are still being receipted.
