Trash and Recycle Updates

Republic Services will reinstate bulk item pick up beginning May 5th, 2020. Residences are allowed 7 bags, which cannot exceed 50 pounds - ALL items big and small need to be bagged.



Leaf and Brush Pick-Up is Back on

Leaf and brush pick-up is being reinstated. Please rake your leaves and brush to the street. Place the brush with the cut end facing the street and separate the brush from the leaves. Call City Hall for a Cemetery Brush disposal permit
