Trash and Recycle Updates

Republic Services has been reinstated. Each residence can have up to six bags of 50 lbs or less - make sure to tie them up. One large/bulk item will also be picked up each week.

Recycling has also been reinstated. Recycling is picked up on a biweekly basis. Upcoming dates include: June 3rd, June 17th, July 1st

Leaf & Brush Pick-Up Schedule

Leaf pickup will occur on a weekly basis. .

Please place leaves into biodegradable yard waste bags; bags should weigh no more than 40 lbs. Leaf collection will occur every week on Monday morning.

Brush pick up will occur monthly. Please stack brush neatly between the curb and sidewalk with the cut ends facing towards the street. Branches should be no larger than 5" in diameter. Brush piles should be no larger than 4' wide, 8' long and 4' high. Stumps will not be collected. *Residents should place their brush to the curb for collection the last week of the month and the City will pick up the brush during the first week of the proceeding month*
