### City Wide Clean Up June 26th and June 27th!

The City of Evart will be holding our annual City Wide Clean Up on Saturday, June 26th, and Sunday, June 27th between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm. There will be dumpsters available at the Waste Water Treatment Plant located at 611 W. Tenth Street. Proof of residency will be required - this can be a water bill, tax bill, or driver's license. Please note, the following materials will NOT be accepted: yard waste, construction materials, demolition debris, concrete, liquids, paints, pesticides, chemicals, and tires. We are hoping to have a tire collection during the last week of May at the Middlebranch Township Hall in Marion, however details have not yet been confirmed. Visit www.evart.org for updates.
