Ballots should be mailed in or dropped off at the Ferry County Courthouse (elections office) at 350 E Delaware Ave in Republic or at the 3 other locations The Curlew Fire Station on 30 Customs Rd.; Republic City Hall at 987 S Clark Ave and San Poil Valley Community Health Center at 11665 S Hwy 21 in Keller until 8:00 p.m. February 8, 2022. Drop Boxes will be picked up on February 7th final pick up will be on February 9, 2022. Mail in ballots must be post marked by election day February 8, 2022. Accessible voting equipment is located in the elections office in the County Courthouse basement on the right. Please call or come by the Auditors Office if you need to get a replacement ballot.
