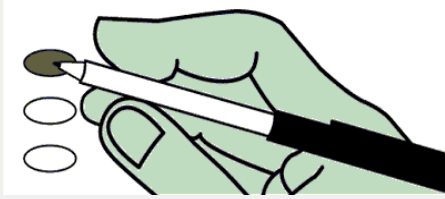


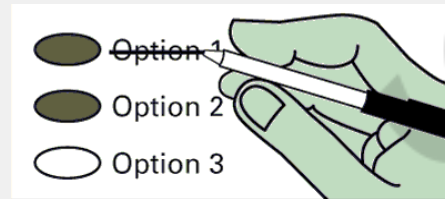
**Instructions**

Use a dark blue or black ink pen to completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice. Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

To vote for a candidate not listed for that race, fill in the oval provided to the left of "Write-in" and print the name clearly on the line.

**Advisory Vote No. 36  
Engrossed Second House Bill 1477**

The legislature imposed, without a vote of the people, a 988 behavioral health crisis response and suicide prevention tax on telephone lines, costing \$432,000,000 in its first ten years, for government spending.

**This tax increase should be:**

- Repealed
- Maintained

**Advisory Vote No. 37  
Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 5096**

The legislature imposed, without a vote of the people, a 7% tax on capital gains in excess of \$250,000, with exceptions, costing \$5,736,000,000 in its first ten years, for government spending.

**This tax increase should be:**

- Repealed
- Maintained

**Advisory Vote No. 38  
Second Substitute Bill 5315**

The legislature imposed, without a vote of the people, a tax on captive insurers in the amount of 2% of premiums from owners/affiliates, costing \$53,000,000 in its first ten years, for government spending.

- Repealed

**PROPOSITION NO. 1  
REPLACEMENT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS AND OPERATION LEVY**

The Board of Directors of Republic School District No. 309 adopted Resolution No. 2021-07-01, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to meet the educational needs of its students by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State (including music, athletics and early childhood learning):

**PROPOSITION NO. 2**

**CAPITAL LEVY FOR LIFE SAFETY, SECURITY AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS**

The Board of Directors of Republic School District No. 309 adopted Resolution No. 2021-07-02, concerning a proposition to finance life safety, security and infrastructure improvements. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, on all taxable property within the District, to make life safety, security and infrastructure improvements (including replacing/repairing roofs; upgrading HVAC; replacing elementary school fire suppression system; remodeling main entrances; and installing entry controls and security cameras):
