

FERRY COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2017-02
AMENDMENT TO PLANNING ORDINANCE SIGNED ON AUGUST 21ST, 1961

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have determined that an overall plan of development of Ferry County is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, it has been determined that the most feasible manner of arriving at a long range plan of development for Ferry County would be by means of establishing a planning commission for Ferry County, and such a procedure has been authorized by legislative enactment; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the 5th day of June, 1961, at 1:30 p.m., in the Ferry County Commissioners Office, and there were no objections made to the establishment of a Ferry County planning commission, and there was much public sentiment in favor of establishing such a planning commission,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED that the County Commissioners of Ferry County established a planning commission as authorized by R.C.W 36.70, of nine (9) members and three (3) ex-officio members; and


WHEREAS, a Planning Department was created and is administered under the County as any other Department and the Planning Director has functioned as the primary administrator of planning duties in the County for at least 30 years; and

WHEREAS, this Planning Commission has served as an advisory board to the Planning Director since the time of the Department's creation,


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED the Ferry County Commissioners believe the intent of this Ordinance was to follow R.C.W 36.70.040, deeming the planning commission as an advisory board to the Planning Director.
