August 5th - 8:00 PM deadline for in-person voter registration and voter updates.

Getting registered to vote

To register to vote, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States.
- A legal resident of Washington State.
- At least 18 years old by the General Election.
- Not currently serving a Department of Corrections sentence in total confinement.

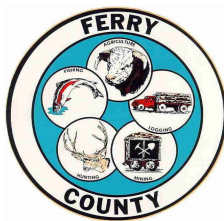

Returning your ballot

By mail

Postage is prepaid - no stamp is needed. Ballots must be postmarked on or before election day, August 5th, 2025 in order to be counted.

In a ballot drop box

Ballot Drop Boxes are available June 20th through 8:00 p.m. Election Day - August 5th, 2025:

FAQ's

What is an explanatory statement?

An explanatory statement is prepared by the district's attorney; it outlines the effect the ballot measure would have if it is passed by the voters.

How are committees in favor of or in opposition to a measure formed?

Districts that choose to participate in the local voters' pamphlet are responsible for appointing committee members who agree to write the statements. The statements are a way to persuade voters to vote for or against a measure. The Elections Office does not check statements for factual or grammatical accuracy.

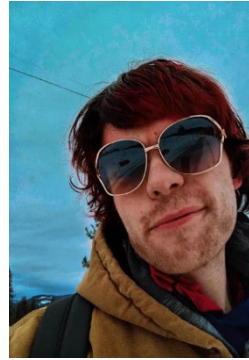
