

Boating season has begun! The following are the Village's regulations regarding boats and trailers:

Parking on residential lots that border the Fox River: Minimum of three feet from the sidewalk or ten feet from the street – unless parked in a garage.

Parking on residential lots that do not border the Fox River: December 1 – March 31, no parking in the front yard unless within a garage. April 1 – November 30, minimum of three feet from the sidewalk or ten feet from the street – unless parked in a garage.

There is no motorized boat launching allowed in any of the parks. Enjoy a safe and fun boating season!

Hello Friends and Neighbors,

We are excited to announce that the building demolition on Block B, encompassing the downtown parcels between Illinois Street and Lincoln Avenue from Northwest Highway to Opatrny Drive, has been successfully completed. Once the ground has been restored, the site will be seeded and the construction fence will be removed. This marks a significant step forward in the Village's ongoing efforts to revitalize our downtown area. The removal of these outdated structures sets the stage for future development, and we are actively engaged in discussions with several potential developers. Our goal is to select the right partner who will bring a vibrant and successful redevelopment project to life in this prime location.

Progress is also visible at the Redwood development on Route 22. As of the

writing of this letter, utility connections are currently underway, and we are on track to see the first buildings completed by the end of the year. This development promises to add value, housing diversity and enhance the living options within our Village.

This year's capital projects are progressing well. The water main installation on Millard has been completed, and site restoration is underway. The road resurfacing program and the addition of new sidewalks are on schedule to be finished by mid-summer. Additionally, all fire hydrants in the Village will be repainted by this fall, ensuring they are in top condition and clearly visible.

I would like to remind everyone about the next Meet with Mayor Marc, scheduled for June 11th. This is an excellent opportunity to have an informal discussion with me and Village staff about the latest developments and other matters of interest in our community. I hope you can join us.



PARKING AND BUS ROUTES

No parking is allowed in or near the park —walk on over or take the free shuttle buses (see the routes below):

Old Hunt Road/Plum Tree Road, Old Hunt Road/Lexington Road, Foxmoor Road/Yorkshire Drive, Algonquin Road Fire Station

Route #3 ~ South Route (one bus)

Algonquin Road School, Lion's Park, Commuter/Metra Lot

Fireworks Reminders...

- No entry after 9 p.m. For safety purposes, you may not enter through the front gate once the fireworks are about to begin.
- No carry-in food or drink. Other than a non-alcoholic drink in one hand, there will be no carry-ins of alcohol, pop, or snacks. Please make it easy on the volunteers policing the grounds and support the local groups that are donating their time and profits to help pay for the fireworks.
- **No pets.** You may love your dog, but they may scare others in attendance or make a mess in a crowded area, so no pets please.
- Be aware of private property. Do not trespass as you make your way to and from the park. Many wooded areas are private, so please stay on designated walking areas.
- **Don't litter.** Please pick up your area before you leave to help keep our park clean.

Proper Flag Disposal

AMVETS Post 245 of Cary-Grove is providing mail drop boxes to properly dispose of American flags that are no longer fit for flying. The retired flag drop boxes are located at Algonquin Township and in FRG across the street from the Village Hall at 400 Lucille Ave. and can be utilized any time.

On Flag Day, June 14th, Cary Grove AMVETS Post 245 will host a flag retirement ceremony at our new location at Algonquin Township (3702 US Highway 14, Crystal Lake) at 2:00 p.m. in the back.
