Trustee Fleischmann requested an overview from Mr. Jim Williams on what transpired between the permit being issued, with approved renderings, for the sign variance to the current situation. Mr. Williams explained that the change in the businesses petroleum contract required a sign change to meet the new agreement with Mobil Oil. During the construction phase, the attempt to drop the pole sign and use the existing foundation, left a bit of foundation exposed, so the brick wall was extended to cover it. Trustee McLaughlin expressed his understanding of the situation and stated he was okay allowing the sign to remain.
