

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-027

**ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF
BRICK STREET TO JAY SAVAGE STREET**

WHEREAS, the City Commission has received a request that Brick Street in Franklin, Kentucky be re-named to Jay Savage Street in memory and honor of Jay Savage who passed away a lifelong resident of Franklin on September 18, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners recognizes that Jay Savage was a dedicated public servant who served on the Planning and Zoning Commission for more than 20 years, and served as Vice-Chairman and Chairman of said Commission for several of those years; and

WHEREAS, Jay Savage tirelessly volunteered his time in helping to improve the community parks system by performing concrete work, bricking and helping to build the pavilions at Breckinridge Park, Lincoln Park, and the Franklin-Simpson Community Park; and

WHEREAS, Jay Savage was a founding member of the Gentlemen's Unlimited organization, a charitable organization which has improved the quality of life for many residents of Franklin and Simpson County; and

WHEREAS, Jay Savage further served the community as a volunteer and coach for youth league baseball leagues for many years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Franklin, Kentucky, acting by and through its Board of Commissioners, that Brick Street, located in the corporate city limits of the City of Franklin and as identified on the map attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, shall be renamed to Jay Lane Savage Street.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval, and publication. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

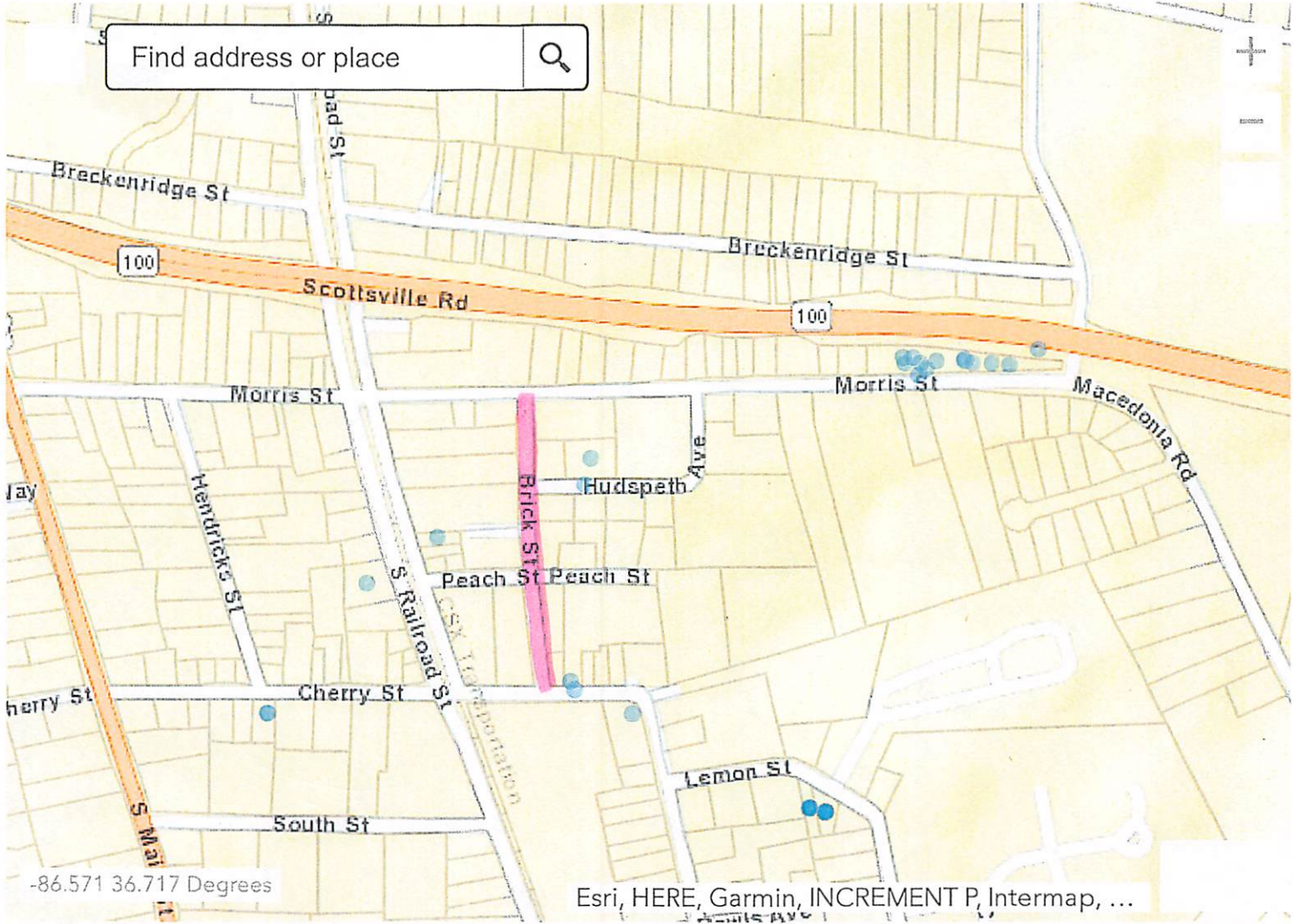
