The purpose of the meeting as listed on the advance agenda was to conduct a work session to discuss the second amendment for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 budget.

Finance Director Cornwell discussed the Covid-19 budgetary impacts on projected revenue and expenditures; adjustment to the operating line items; adjustment to capital projects; the capital sinking fund; proposed community service requests; and, the proposed budget amendment ordinance.

Following the budget amendment discussion, Cornwell asked for two sponsors of the budget amendment ordinance. Commissioner Powell and Commission Stewart asked to sponsor the proposed ordinance.

ORDINANCE


