The purpose of the meeting as listed on the advance agenda was to conduct a work session to discuss the proposed Fiscal Year 2020-2021 first budget amendment.


Finance Director Cornwell presented the Commission with updated revenue and capital expenditures along with the proposed first budget amendment ordinance.


No Commission action was taken at this time regarding the proposed Fiscal Year 2020-2021 first budget amendment.
