Ordinance No. 2021-016 titled: An Ordinance of the City of Franklin, Kentucky Providing for the Creation and Sale of a Non-Exclusive Franchise for the Privilege of Constructing, Maintaining and Distributing Natural Gas Along and Under Public Right-of-Way Within the City of Franklin, Kentucky for a Term of Twenty (20) Years in Consideration For which, the Successful Franchisee Shall Pay to the City an Annual Sum Equal to a Minimum of One Percent (1%) of the Gross Revenues Derived from the Franchise Award Herein; and Further Establishing a Bid Procedure for the Award of Said Franchise to the Successful Bidder




ADJOURNMENT
