Ordinance B 2013-2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2013 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2014 BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Franklin, Kentucky is required by law to amend its budget ordinance to reflect actual revenues and expenditures if different from those projected; and,

WHEREAS, it has been reported to the City Commission that actual revenues collected and costs expended by the City during the 2013-2014 fiscal year are different from those projected in the current budget ordinance and it is therefore necessary to amend the 2013-2014 budget ordinance to reflect these variances,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Franklin, Kentucky that the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 budget is hereby amended to read as follows:
