**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2016-012 ENTITLED  
“PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE ENFORCEMENT”  
REGARDING COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD**

WHEREAS, the City has become aware of new regulations regarding the necessity to withhold taxes from members of boards appointed by City Commissioners;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Franklin, Kentucky, deems it reasonable and necessary to revise this ordinance to provide the flexibility to set the compensation of the Code Board and have the ability to amend said rate from time-to-time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 5(h) of the Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:**

- (h) Members of the Franklin-Simpson Code Enforcement Board shall be reimbursed for actual expenses and compensated in ~~the amount of \$50.00 per meeting~~ an amount to be set by the Board of Commissioners and/or Fiscal Court by motion as amended from time to time.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption as provided by law.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of Ordinance.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
