**Homework Club**  
Guidelines for Families

✍ Homework Club will be held in the afternoon for a period of no longer than 45 minutes at each Solutions site. If possible, the children will go to a separate quiet area with desks or tables.

✍ A list of Homework Club participants will be kept on file at each site.

✍ It will be a positive environment. Homework Club should not be a forced activity or unpleasant for any child.

✍ Each child must have a Homework Club form that they have signed and that has also been signed by their parent/guardian. A child's participation is an agreement between the child and their parent/guardian.

✍ Solutions staff will encourage and assist the children as much as possible with their Homework by offering resources and support.

✍ The completion of Homework, including proof reading, revising or correcting the children's work is the responsibility of the child and their parent/guardian.

✍ If a child cannot complete their homework during the allotted 45 minutes they may continue to work on their homework while at Solutions, however, it will not have the same atmosphere as the traditional Homework Club.

✍ Issues that may arise during Homework Club will be addressed by the Site Coordinator to the parent/guardian of the child. Examples of issues may include:

The child has difficulty focusing on homework and/or completing homework.

The child is disruptive during homework club.

The child refuses to participate in homework club.

There are discrepancies in homework.

✍ Parents/Guardians should address questions or concerns regarding their child's homework to the classroom teacher.
