

How to Make a Bee Feeder

Materials:

Mason Jar (or any other glass jar)

Sugar

Hot Water

Shallow Pan

Small Pebbles or rocks



Instructions:

Fill a mason jar half way with sugar.

Fill the jar with hot water and shake it up to melt the sugar.
Let the sugar water cool.

Drill a bunch of small holes in the lid. And replace the lid.

Make a small layer of pebbles in the bottom of a shallow pan. This will give the bees a perch to sit on.

Place the jar upside down on the rocks.

Place in an area outside and watch the bees come and enjoy a free meal!
