To line up the wheels with the opening on the front of the cover, place the cover over the wheel then adjust 'ti the dashed lines on the the cover match up to the solid lines of the pie wheel underneath.

Flip over and poke a hole in the center X on the back of the pie wheel, so that it goes all the way through to the cover. I use a protractor.

Insert a brass brad through the front hole, and open the prongs on the back.

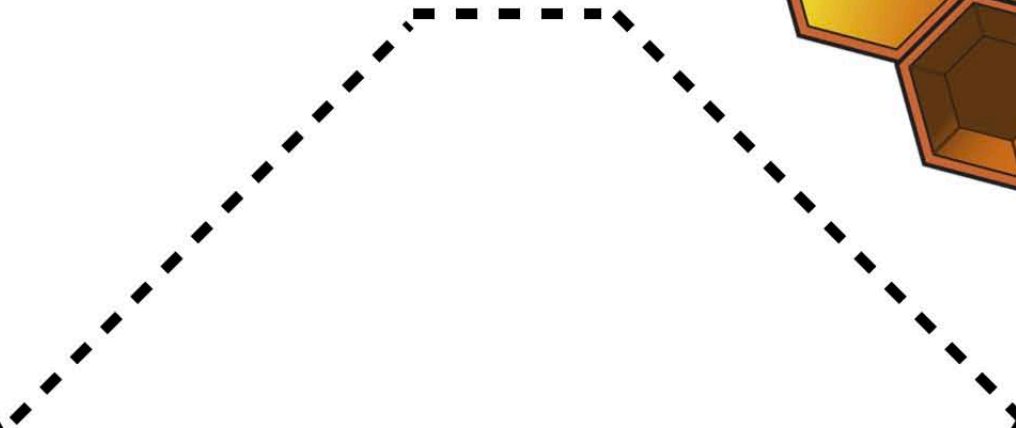
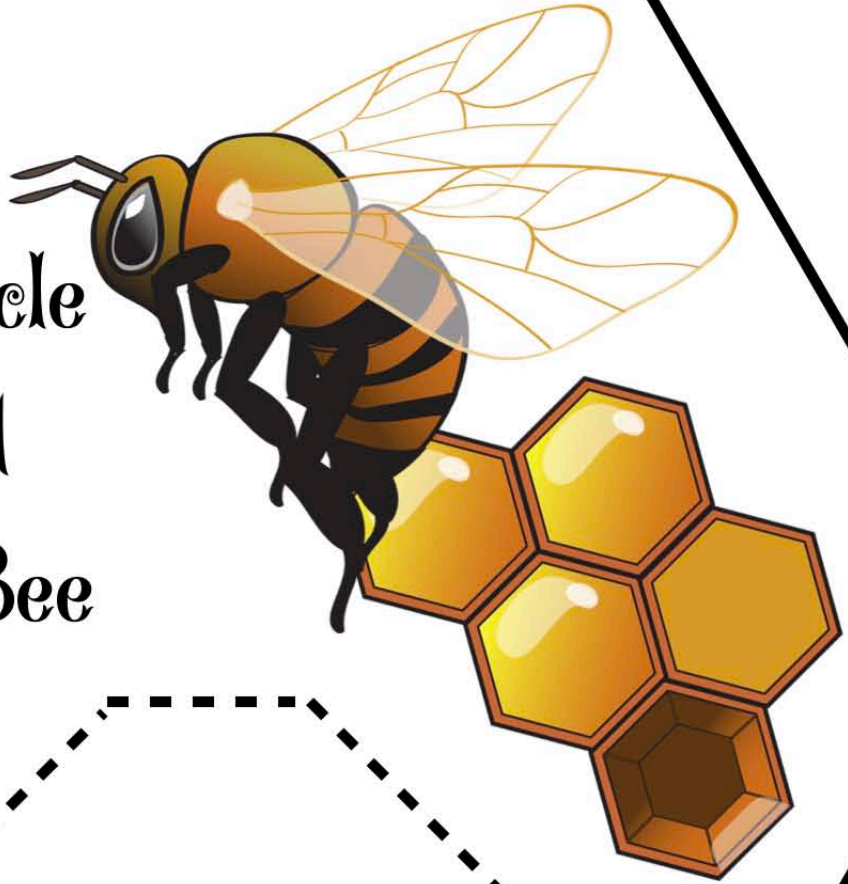
Students can also write their name on the back of their wheel.

Children hang on to the cover with their left hand, and using their thumb and index finger of their right hand, turn the wheel up from left to right.

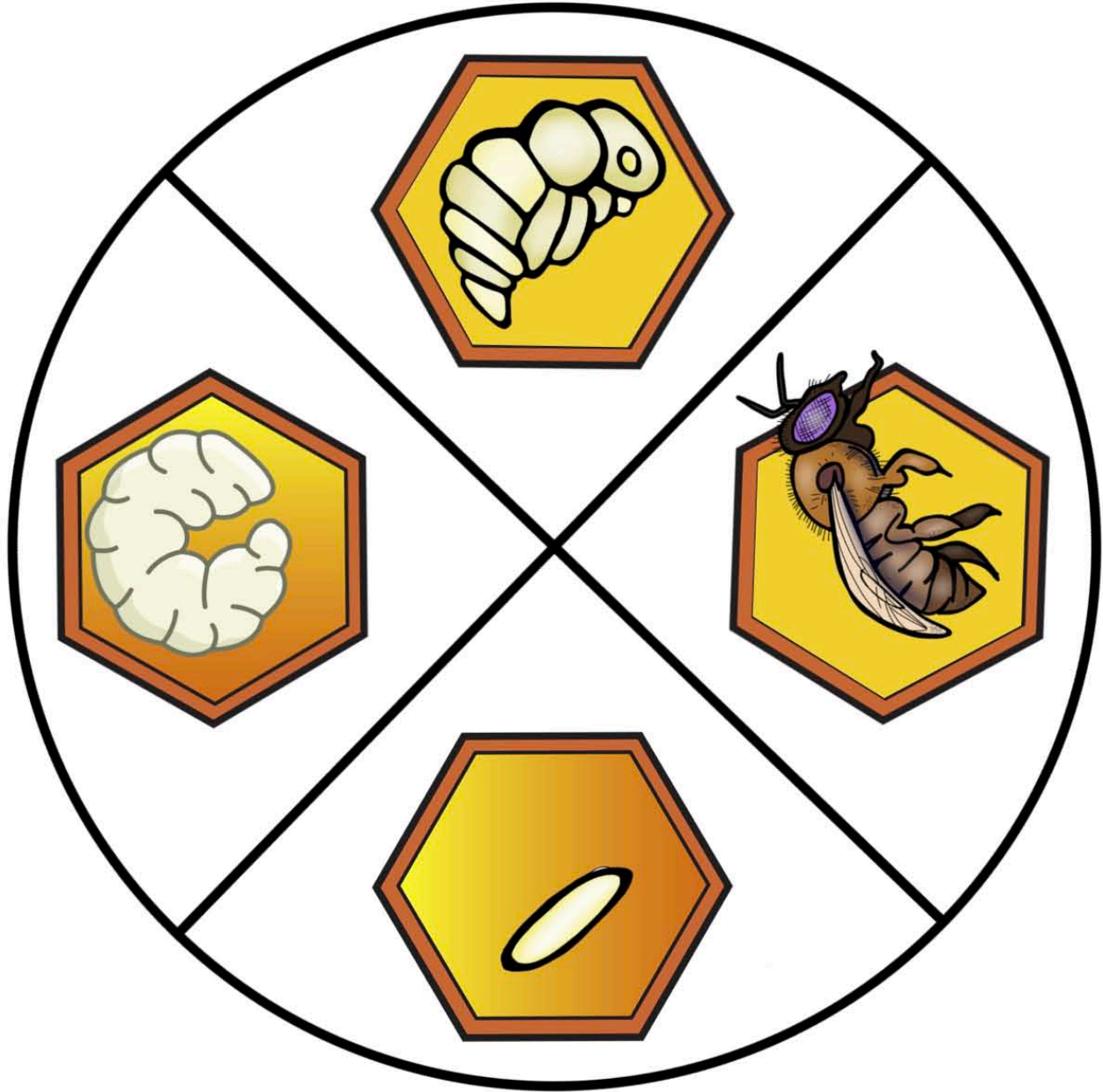
Go through the various stages as a whole group, then have children pick a partner and take turns explaining the life cycle of the honey bee to each other.
