Dear Ride-Along Program Applicant,

The Ride-Along Program at the Glendale Police Department is designed to provide an opportunity to citizens to observe law enforcement officers in action and to become familiar with the Glendale Police Department's patrol operations.

The Glendale Police Department requires that all participants be neatly attired when riding in a patrol vehicle. The accepted mode of dress is a shirt/blouse, slacks, shoes and a coat/jacket when applicable.

Participants are asked not to leave the patrol vehicle on specific police assignments unless their assistance is requested by the police officer with whom they are riding with. This policy is necessary to protect the citizen from any eventuality of body harm, no matter how remote. The role participants' play is strictly that of an observer. They may not become involved verbally or physically with any suspects the police officer is questioning or with whom the police officer comes in contact with.

Prior to completion of the application, please review the Rules and Regulations provided in this packet. You will be required to adhere to all rules and regulations stated within, as well as the directions of the police officer with whom you are riding with. Failure to adhere to these rules and regulations will result in the termination of the Ride-Along participation.

RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

- 1. Ride-Along Program participants are <u>OBSERVERS ONLY</u> and shall not become involved in or interfere, verbally or physically, with police personnel while they are engaged in their official duties.
- 2. The Ride-Along Program participant WILL NOT be allowed to carry a weapon of any kind.
- 3. The Ride-Along Program participant will adhere to all orders of police personnel.
- 4. The Ride-Along participant will be allowed to observe as much of any situation or function as is possible, consistent with the participant's and/or others' safety.
- 5. The Ride-Along participant will not put himself or herself in any position which might endanger the lives or safety of himself or herself, police personnel of others.
- 6. No cameras, voice recorders or any other recording devices are permitted to be brought on the Ride-Along Program or function without expressed written permission from the Chief of Police. Such permission must be requested upon submission of the application to the program and be obtained in advance of participation in any program or function.
- 7. Ride-Along participation will be terminated if the participant fails to follow the above stated rules and regulations of the Ride-Along Program, or if the participant is acting in a manner inconsistent with the best interest of the Glendale Police Department.
- 8. The participant may request that his or her participation be terminated at any time as well.
- 9. The participant must be twenty-one years of age or older to participate in the Ride-Along Program. Participants eighteen to twenty years of age may be considered with parental permission.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM. I FULLY UNDERSTAND THEM AND WILL COMPLY WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE GLENDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM.
