MON, 12/19, 9:21 AM	Police investigated a report of numerous violations of the overnight parking ordinance in the 200 block of Edwin Avenue. Five (5) warning tickets were issued.
MON, 12/19, 10:10 AM	Officers responded to the St. Louis City Police Impound Lot and processed the recovered stolen vehicle for evidence. The vehicle was reported stolen on 10/25/2022 and recovered on Sunday, 12/18/2022.
