While returning to the city from conducting a follow up investigation at a local hospital, an officer observed a single vehicle crash (unoccupied) on eastbound Interstate 44, just west of Lindbergh Boulevard. A short time later, two Missouri State Highway Patrol troopers arrived on the scene to investigate. While all three officers were inside their patrol vehicles with emergency lights activated, they were struck by a tractor-trailer, causing serious injuries to one of the troopers and minor injuries to the other trooper and Glendale officer. The driver of the tractor-trailer, a 62-year-old Flint, Michigan man, was arrested at the scene and charged by the St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office with two counts of Driving While Intoxicated Causing Injury to Law Enforcement Personnel and one count of Failure to Yield to an Emergency Vehicle. Bond was set at \$100,000.
