MON, 1/9, 2:57 AM	Officers investigated a 911 Hang Up Call from a cell phone in the area of Hawbrook and Park Avenues. There was no evidence of any emergency located.
MON, 1/9, 12:16 PM	Officers investigated a complaint of leaves raked to the curb and left there in the 200 block of Elm Avenue. The residents advised they were in the process of getting them picked up.
MON, 1/9, 5:16 PM	A student from North Glendale School reported that, while riding his bicycle home from school, a middle-aged man driving a gray pickup truck, with a teen-aged passenger, followed him home. The student recognized this as odd and took a different route home and rode his bicycle into a random driveway. The vehicle drove away.
