MON, 7/10, 12:12 AM	Officers assisted the Warson Woods Police Department with a report of a suspicious person in the area of Manchester Road and Andrew Drive.
MON, 7/10, 6:50 AM	Officers responded to a report of an injured cat lying in the roadway near N. Sappington Road and Brookside Drive. The cat was dead upon arrival and was disposed of.

Police are investigating.

The resident recognized this as a scam and disconnected communication with the caller. The resident advised she knew this was a popular fraud technique and wished to alert others to the scheme.
