AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING DAVID GILLEN TO THE POSITION OF POLICE OFFICER ON A PART-TIME BASIS, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

**SECTION I** David Gillen is hereby appointed to the position of Police Officer, on a part-time basis not to exceed 30 hours per week per year, and shall receive \$22.00 per hour effective as of today's date. This appointment will incorporate a one-year probationary period effective upon passage and is contingent upon successful completion of pre-employment requirements.

**SECTION II** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety, as provided by Ohio Revised Code 731.30 and shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
