ORDINANCE 2021-14**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF 2021 ESTIMATED REVENUE AND APPROPRIATIONS OF THE CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND, A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members there of concurring:

**SECTION I** The Village of Glendale passed Resolution 2020-16 affirming participation and agreement to the guidelines of the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund June 29, 2020; and

**SECTION II** That the Village of Glendale has been awarded \$100,000 in grant funding from the Hamilton County Community Development Block Grant program for the improvements to the playground equipment at Cleveland Park in the Village of Glendale; and

**SECTION III** It is necessary to account for this grant funding and therefore to increase both the 2021 estimated revenue and appropriations of the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF), which are to be posted as listed; and

**SECTION IV** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and or safety, as provided by Ohio Revised Code 731.10. Specifically, emergency action is necessary to ensure the timely and efficient payment of Village invoices, to ensure the continuation of important Village projects, and to ensure the proper administration of Village affairs. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
