AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE MAYOR'S DECISION TO PLACE CHIEF HARDWICK  
ON ADMINISTRATIVE LEAVE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

**SECTION I** Effective March 25, 2022, Fire Chief Kevin Hardwick was placed on paid administrative leave by Mayor Donald Lofty. Said leave shall remain in place until his retirement date of April 9, 2022, subject to certain conditions set forth in the notice of leave.

**SECTION II** This decision is hereby ratified by the Council of the Village of Glendale.

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING BJ JETTER TO THE POSITION OF ACTING FIRE CHIEF  
ON A PART-TIME BASIS, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION, AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

**SECTION I** Glendale Assistant Fire Chief BJ Jetter is now hereby appointed to the position of Acting Fire Chief, on a part-time basis not to exceed 30 hours per week, and shall receive \$24.86 per hour effective March 28, 2022.

**SECTION II** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and or safety, as provided by Ohio Revised Code 731.30. Specifically, emergency action is necessary to ensure the proper administration of Village affairs. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
