**ORDINANCE 2022-30**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF 2022 APPROPRIATIONS OF THE VILLAGE PLAN AND GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS,** the need has been identified for replacement radio equipment for the Glendale Police and Fire Departments to ensure full functionality with County and State radio systems; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village of Glendale receives a substantial grant from the State Fire Marshal for the purchase of these radios, on condition that the order be placed no later than June 3, 2022;

**BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

**SECTION I** The 2022 appropriations for the Village Plan and General Improvement Fund are to be increased as listed:

<u>Acct.</u>	<u>Dept.; Description</u>	<u>Appropriation Increase</u>
404.101.2521	Police; Equipment	\$38,000
404.102.2521	Fire; Equipment	\$42,500

**SECTION II** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety, as provided by Ohio Revised Code 731.30. Specifically, emergency action is necessary to ensure the timely and efficient payment of Village invoices and to ensure the continuation of important Village projects.
