ORDINANCE 2022-04**

AN ORDINANCE INSERTING CHAPTER 154.59 IN THE VILLAGE OF GLENDALE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS RELATED TO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL SIGNAGE IN THE VILLAGE OF GLENDALE, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE GLENDALE PLANNING AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2021, the Glendale Planning and Historic Preservation Commission (GPHPC), upon the suggestion of an ad hoc committee, led by Vice Chair Thomas Kerr, voted to initiate the amendment procedure under §154.66 of the Glendale Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2021, the GPHPC, following a public hearing, unanimously approved GPHPC Resolution 2021-003, recommending approval of amendments to §154.42 and §154.46 of the Glendale Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2021, the Village Clerk caused notice of a Council public hearing on the draft amendments to be published in the Cincinnati Court Index, a newspaper of general circulation in the Village, with said notice describing the nature of the request and providing the Council hearing date and time, all consistent with the Clerk's obligations under §154.66 of the Glendale Zoning Code;

WHEREAS, on December 6, 2021, the Council of the Village of Glendale conducted a public hearing on the amendments recommended by the GPHPC and at the hearing, Council heard from members of the public;

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2022 Council tabled the Ordinance to Amend the Zoning Code regarding signs and requested further consideration by the GPHPC;

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2022, following meetings and consideration by the ad hoc committee and the decision of the US Supreme Court in Austin v. Reagan National Advertising regarding off-premises advertising such as billboards, the GPHPC approved an amended version of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed and considered the amended proposed Ordinance;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION I Section 154.37 of the Glendale Zoning Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and amended as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference

SECTION II All other sections of the Glendale Zoning Code, Chapter 154 of the Glendale Code of Ordinances, are to remain as written.

SECTION III The Village Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

RESOLUTION 2022-32

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONDITIONAL USE OF LAND AT 1021 MORSE AVENUE FOR AN IN-GROUND SWIMMING POOL TO BE CONSTRUCTED PURSUANT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, on November 7, 2022 and December 5, 2022, the Glendale Planning and Historic Preservation Commission (“GPHPC”) reviewed the conditional use application filed requesting permission to install an in-ground swimming pool on the property located at 1021 Morse Avenue in the “A” zoning district; and

WHEREAS, after considering all of the information presented to it, the GPHPC recommended approval of the conditional use application, provided certain conditions set forth in Section I below are met; and

WHEREAS, as required under Section 154.62 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Glendale, the GPHPC forwarded the recommendation to the Village Council for approval, disapproval or approval with conditions; and

WHEREAS, Village Council has considered the recommendation and heard from interested parties regarding the application;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring:

SECTION I Village Council hereby approves the conditional use application, subject to the following conditions:

1. Location per the site plan originally submitted to, and approved by, GPHPC on November 7, 2022.
2. Compliance with fencing regulations per the Glendale Codified Ordinances Section 154.55(I)(4) and the Building Code.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT OF 2022 APPROPRIATIONS OF THE
GLENDALE FIRE APPARATUS FUND AND VILLAGE PLAN AND GENERAL
IMPROVEMENT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Fire Committee met November 14, 2022 and recommended the purchase of a replacement fire pumper to replace the 1999 Freightliner Pumper; and

WHEREAS, the replacement pumper, a Sutphen Heavy Duty Custom Pumper Complete, has been competitively bid through Sourcewell, contract number 113021-SUT; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds expeditiously to permit the Village to enter into an agreement to purchase the replacement pumper to avoid increased pricing;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION I The 2022 appropriations for the Glendale Fire Apparatus Fund are to be increased as listed:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HERITAGE FIRE EQUIPMENT, AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE FOR SUTPHEN CORPORATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SUTPHEN HEAVY DUTY CUSTOM PUMPER COMPLETE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Glendale has passed Ordinance 2022-59 authorizing the appropriation of the necessary funds to purchase the Sutphen Heavy Duty Custom Pumper Complete at a price of \$830,228.72; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to expeditiously enter into an agreement with Heritage Fire Preservation for the purchase of the apparatus to avoid price increases or delay;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION I Heritage Fire Equipment, authorized representative for the Sutphen Corporation, is hereby awarded the contract for the purchase of a Sutphen Heavy Duty Custom Pumper Complete, being competitively bid through Sourcewell, of which the Village is a member, at a price of \$830,228.72.

SECTION II The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Heritage Fire Equipment for an amount not to exceed \$803,228.72 and shall authorize timely payments upon delivery of the apparatus, which is currently estimated to be 30 months from the data of signing.

SECTION III This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety, as provided by Ohio Revised Code 731.30. Specifically, emergency action is necessary to ensure the timely and efficient payment of Village invoices and to ensure the continuation of important Village projects.

AN ORDINANCE ADDRESSING THE PROVISIONS OF AMENDED SUBSTITUTE H.B. 172; ADOPTING GLENDALE, OHIO CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE IX, CHAPTER 97, FIREWORKS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2021, the Ohio General Assembly passed Amended Substitute House Bill 172 (“H.B. 172”) concerning, among other things, the regulation, possession, discharge, ignition and exploding of fireworks in the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Governor DeWine signed H.B. 172 into law on November 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, various aspects of H.B. 172 will, without legislative action by Ohio municipalities and other governmental entities, permit the discharge, ignition and/or exploding of what are commonly referred to as “fireworks” on certain conditions and on certain days of the year; and

WHEREAS, provisions of H.B. 172 (including what is now RC 3743.45(D) and (E) and RC 3743.451(B)) expressly grant municipalities with home rule authority the right to retain all or any municipal ordinances that regulate and/or prohibit the discharge, ignition or exploding of fireworks and to retain all Ordinances that regulate noise, disturbance of the peace and disorderly conduct; and

WHEREAS, the discharge, ignition and/or exploding of fireworks poses significant danger to the public and will cause injuries as well as property damage, particularly in Glendale where there is an abundance of historic homes and significant tree canopy and other vegetation; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to opt-out of H.B. 172; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to further adopt regulations which regulate and/or prohibit the discharge, ignition or exploding of fireworks;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION I The Village Council hereby adopts Title IX, Chapter 97 of the Glendale, Ohio Code of Ordinances, titled “Fireworks,” attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference herein; and

SECTION II The Village of Glendale, Ohio affirmatively opts out of the provisions of H.B. 172 that would and do otherwise allow for the use of fireworks as specified therein; and

SECTION III This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety, as provided by

ORDINANCE 2022-62**

CHAPTER 97: FIREWORKS

Section

97.01 Definitions

97.02 Unauthorized Possession, Sale, Or Discharge of Fireworks

97.99 Penalty.

§ 97.01 DEFINITIONS.

- (a) "Fireworks" means any composition or device prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect by combustion, deflagration, or detonation, except ordinary matches and except as provided in R.C. § 3743.80.
- (b) "Licensed exhibitor of fireworks" or "licensed exhibitor" means a person licensed pursuant to R.C. §§ 3743.50 through 3743.55.

§ 97.02 UNAUTHORIZED POSSESSION, SALE, OR DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS

- (a) No person shall possess for sale or sell fireworks in this village.
- (b) No person shall possess fireworks in this village, except a licensed exhibitor of fireworks as authorized by R.C. §§ 3743.50 through 3743.55, and except as provided in R.C. § 3743.80.
- (c) Except as provided in R.C. § 3743.80 and except for licensed exhibitors of fireworks authorized to conduct a fireworks exhibition pursuant to R.C. §§ 3743.50 through 3743.55, no person shall discharge, ignite, or explode any fireworks in this village.
- (d) No person shall transport fireworks in the village except in accordance with rules adopted by the State Fire Marshal pursuant to R.C. § 3743.58.

§ 97.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provision of this chapter for which no penalty is otherwise provided, shall be fined \$150.00 for the first offense in a calendar year and is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Whoever violates any provision of this chapter for which no penalty is otherwise provided, and whose said offense is the second offense under this chapter in a calendar year, shall be fined \$250.00 and is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. Whoever violates any provision of this chapter for which no penalty is otherwise provided, and whose said offense is the third or any additional offense under this chapter in a calendar year, shall be fined \$500.00 and is guilty of misdemeanor of the third degree.

Penalties:

For most traffic charges:

If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one predicate motor vehicle or traffic offense, a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.

If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to two or more predicate motor vehicle or traffic offenses, a misdemeanor of the third degree.

For speeding charges:

If, within one year of the offense, the offender has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to two (2) violations of any provision of Section 73.10 (A) through (I) a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.

If, within one year of the offense, the offender has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to three (3) or more violations of any provision of Section 73.10 (A) through (I) a misdemeanor of the third degree.

These provisions also apply to State Code and/or any municipal ordinance that is substantially equivalent to provisions of Section 73.10 (A) through (I).

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ALL 2023 GENERAL FUND, ENTERPRISE FUND, SPECIAL REVENUE FUND, AND MISCELLANEOUS FUND BUDGETS, AND PROVIDING WAGE ADJUSTMENTS, AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED "EXHIBIT A", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Glendale, State of Ohio, a majority of all members thereof concurring, that:

SECTION I The 2023 General Fund, Enterprise Fund, Special Revenue Fund and Miscellaneous Fund budgets, having been prepared and recommended for adoption by the Village Administration, reviewed and recommended for adoption by the appropriate Committees of Council and the Finance Committee of the Whole, attached herein as "Exhibit A", are hereby approved.

SECTION II As recommended by the appropriate Committees and Finance Committee of the Whole, the following wage adjustments are hereby approved to be paid from the General and Enterprise Funds in 2023:

All eligible full- and part-time employees, following a supervisor's annual employee performance appraisal, shall receive an increase of 5%, effective 1/1/2023.

Certain employees, as determined by supervisors and Mayor, shall receive additional compensation based on performance and position, effective 1/1/2023.

SECTION III This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and or safety, as provided by Ohio Revised Code 731.50. Specifically, emergency action is necessary to ensure the timely and efficient payment of Village invoices, to ensure the continuation of important Village projects, and to ensure the proper administration of Village affairs. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
