

CITY OF GRANITE FALLS
OFFICIAL CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
EMERGENCY SESSION
March 23, 2010

Mayor David Smiglewski called an emergency session of the Granite Falls City Council to order at 3:15 p.m., Tuesday, March 23, 2010 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. Council members present: Bill Miller, Scott Peterson, Joe Fagnano and Steve Schaub. Council members absent: DuWayne Galow and Steve Nordaune. Staff in attendance: City Manager Bill Lavin and City Clerk Joan Taylor. Others in attendance: Public Works Director Paul Krogstad, Electrical Superintendent Don Reznechek, Water Plant Superintendent Mike Enstad, Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator Jim Finken, City Engineer Dave Berryman, Corps of Engineers personnel, Yellow Medicine County representatives and Stony Run Township representatives. Mayor Smiglewski announced that the purpose of the emergency meeting is to discuss the 2010 flood.

DECLARATION OF DISASTER: Miller introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption formally declaring the City of Granite Falls a disaster area.

RESOLUTION NO. 10-40

RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS the Flood of 2010 impacted the population of the City of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS the flood event has caused a significant amount of public property damage; and

WHEREAS it is requested that the City Council of Granite Falls declare the City of Granite Falls in a State of Emergency for the flood event of 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, MINNESOTA, declaring the City of Granite Falls in a State of Emergency for conditions resulting from the flood event of 2010.
