HAZARDOUS BUILDINGS: City Attorney Holmstrom was in attendance to discuss with council the structure located at 605 Highway 212 West. Following discussion, Miller introduced a resolution and moved its adoption ordering the correction or removal of hazardous conditions pursuant to Minnesota Statute 463 of this structure.

RESOLUTION NO. 12-87

RESOLUTION ORDERING CORRECTION OR REMOVAL OF HAZARDOUS CONDITIONS PER MINNESOTA STATUTE 463

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 12-49 the City Council ordered the City Building Inspector and, if necessary, the Fire Chief to inspect said building and make a report of said inspection to the City Council for purposes of making findings and determination of whether or not said buildings constitute a "hazardous building" within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes 463.15; and

WHEREAS, the inspection was scheduled to take place on Thursday, April 19th at 11:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, the owner of property located at 605 Highway 212 West failed to appear at the time scheduled and therefore only an exterior inspection was completed, with the Building Inspection assessing to property for potential violations of Minnesota Statutes 463.15 – 463.261; and

WHEREAS, the Building Inspector found numerous hazardous conditions existing inside and around the exterior of this structure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, MINNESOTA, ordering the owner of the structure located at 605 Highway 212 West, Granite Falls, Minnesota to correct or remove any and all hazardous conditions upon the building and restate pursuant to Minnesota Statute 463.

2013 BUDGET: Council acknowledged receipt of the 2013 budget information.

FLOOD MITIGATION: The city is still awaiting word from the DNR relative to possible additional flood mitigation funding to be received from the 2012 bonding bill.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT/METER REPLACEMENT: Council reviewed the updates relative to the Water Treatment Plant Construction Project and the replacement of meters.

STORM SEWER PROJECTS: Council discussed with City Engineer Berryman the proposed storm sewer project in the Industrial Park and a possible storm sewer project on 8th Avenue. Following discussion and with interest shown in these projects it was the consensus of council to obtain more information relative to possibly changing the assessment policy concerning commercial property and to research possible tax abatement.
