MEDIACOM: Council reviewed a letter recently received from Mediacom relative to an increase in cable and internet rates.

HEALTH GRANT: Staff advised council that the Health Challenge Grant application that was submitted by CURE to Blue Cross/Blue Shield has been approved. These funds will be utilized to establish a Frisbee Golf course as well as canoe/kayak accesses along the riverside city parks.

- FLOOD MITIGATION: The Flood Mitigation Task Force will be meeting on Friday, August 17th. Council was also advised that the city has been notified that the Scenic Byways grant application has been approved for the remaining amount needed for rehabilitation of the pedestrian bridge.
- WATER TREATMENT PLANT: Staff advised council that during the month of September Oak Street will need to be closed to accommodate underground utility connections to the new Water Treatment Plant.
- RIVERVIEW APARTMENTS: Council was advised of a conference call which took place on Monday August 6th with Emmanuel Ku the high bidder on the Riverview Apartments foreclosure sale.
- MN FALLS DAM: Council reviewed emails concerning the draw-down of the Minnesota River.
- 2013 BUDGET: Council reviewed correspondence received from Pioneerland Library Systems requesting a 3% increase in funding from the city for 2013. Staff also advised council that the city has been notified that it will receive \$86,000 additional Local Government Aid in 2013 than it received in 2012. Council was also notified that Head Librarian Madelyn Bronson will be retiring effective September 4th.
- GAMBLING PERMIT: A gambling license application was acknowledged at this time for the YME Hoops Club to hold a raffle. This application was acknowledged with no waiting period.
