OFFICIAL CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
EMERGENCY SESSION
August 10, 2020

Mayor David Smiglewski called an emergency session of the Granite Falls City Council to order at 12:00 p.m., Monday, August 10th in the Council Chambers of City Hall. Council members present: Brad Peterson and Joe Fagnano; via telecom: Steve Nordaune, Scott Peterson, and Sharon Pazi Zea Council member absent: DuWayne Galow. Staff in attendance: City Manager Crystal Johnson, Finance Director Neal Carstensen and City Clerk Christine Kleven. Others in attendance via telecom: Advocate Tribune News Editor Kyle Klausung and Tom Chervany.

Mayor Smiglewski announced that the purpose of the emergency meeting is to discuss the August 8, 2020 storm damage.

Council was given an update concerning damage, the cleanup process currently happening and plans for continued cleanup.

KCC roof was damaged in the storm and has been temporarily patched.

Other City buildings are being assessed.
