SPECIAL SESSION  
November 23, 2020

Mayor David Smiglewski called a special session of the Granite Falls City Council to order at 5:00 p.m., Monday, November 23, 2020, in the Council Chambers of City Hall. Council Members present: DuWayne Galow, Brad Peterson, and Joe Fagnano.
