April 3, 2022 Westport Marina: Ecology received a report of fishing vessel on fire at the marina. Westport Fire Department was able to put the fire out with little damage to the vessel but the pilothouse. Ecology and USCG worked with vessel owner to have the fire-fighting water out of the vessel's bilge.

April 4, 2022 Elma: Grays Harbor PUD reported a 10-gallon spill of mineral oil from a pole mounted transformer to soil due to high winds. No water affected and PUD cleaned up the impacted soil.

April 6, 2022 Elma: Ecology received a report of a garbage truck spilled a quart of hydraulic oil to the roadway. Company cleaned up the roadway. No water was impacted.

April 8, 2022 Aberdeen: City of Aberdeen Code Enforcement requested Ecology assistance with citizens that were selling gasoline out of their home in a trailer park. The citizens were selling jugs of gas from 55-gallon drums stored on their property. Unfortunately, Ecology does not have regulations that prohibit selling gas from your home. Ecology suggested code enforcement contact city/county fire marshal who might be able to shut down the seller's operation.

April 22, 2022 Aberdeen: Ecology responded to a semi-truck fire at Pape Machine. A logging truck that was in for repair caught fire. Aberdeen Fire put the fire out. Ecology Responders found no impact to the city's storm water system.

March 15, 2022 Cosmo: Report received indicated that Chlorine Dioxide line was flushed for maintenance by the night shift bleacherman. Water line was left open & caused the chlorine dioxide liquid storage tank to overflow. Problem was taken care of and all employees checked to be ok.

LEPC Hazmat Plan:

Hazmat plan went through full review by Washington State Emergency Management Division. Overall, they liked the plan but had a few minor changes such as but not limited to language changes, add link to WSP training calendar, add local tribes etc. Next step is to send out to LEPC for review. Once approved this plan will be ready for final approval submission. Deadline is end of 2022 year.
