

How To Apply For A Motor Vehicle Abatement

If you took the vehicle off the road but still own it, you are not eligible for an abatement.

If you no longer own the vehicle we need the following *two* types of documentation *plus* the completed abatement application to process your abatement request.

If the vehicle was:

Sold or Traded: 1. Bill of Sale **or** Trade-In paperwork **and**
2. Plate Return Receipt **or** Registration of the vehicle in which the Plate was transferred to.

Total Loss or Stolen 1. Insurance Settlement Letter **or** Police Report **and**
2. Plate Return Receipt **or** Registration of the Vehicle in which the Plate was transferred to.

Vehicle Junked 1. Receipt from the Junkyard **and**
2. Plate Return Receipt.

Moved From Massachusetts 1. Registration from new state or country **and**
2. Plate Cancellation Receipt
3. If the car was not taken with you, a Bill of Sale, Trade-In paperwork, **or** a letter stating what happened to the vehicle.

Donated 1. Receipt of Donation **and**
2. Plate Cancellation Receipt **or** Registration of the Vehicle in which the plate was transferred to.

Repossessed 1. Notice from Lien holder **and**
2. Plate Cancellation Receipt **or** Registration of the Vehicle in which the plate was transferred to.

Please return the required documentation with the *completed* Abatement Form.
