Housing Rehabilitation: \$250,000

- Partnership with Community Action Pioneer Valley
- Approximately 5 units to be rehabbed, plus set-aside for emergency repairs

Microenterprise Assistance: \$112,500

- Partnership with Franklin County Community Development Corporation (FCCDC)
- Workshops for owners or potential owners of small businesses (5 or fewer employees)
- Investment capital for qualified microenterprises

Water Mains Replacement Design & Engineering: \$201,751

- Bid-ready designs and plans for replacing water mains in the designated Slum & Blight District (downtown Central Commercial zoning district)
- Design & Engineering calculated at 15% of construction costs
- Water mains replacement replacements will take place over approximately next 5 years

Social Services: \$185,000

- Center for Human Development: Greenfield Elder Wellness Program
 - \$35,000
- Center for New Americans: Fostering Immigrant Self-Sufficiency Program
 - \$15,000
- Community Legal Aid: Homelessness Prevention Project
 - \$50,000
- Stone Soup Café: Community Free Store
 - \$40,800
- Wildflower Alliance: Homelessness Prevention Greenfield Expansion
