- Margo will contact city grant writer Athena Lee Bradley about progress on the updating of the city's historic building survey.

New Business:

- Tim suggested that the commission consider choosing another Peter Miller award recipient. He will send out the criteria to all members, and solicit suggestions to be considered at the next meeting.
- Tim also brought the commission up to date on the work of the National Park Service Battlefield Protection Program Advisory Board for the Falls Fight battlefield. He represents the commission on the board. The final grant for the project should be coming soon, and RFPs for archeological work should be going out, as will agreements with the several tribes represented.
