CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Thornton called the City Council to order at 6:30 PM.

ROLL CALL

Mayor Thornton declared a quorum. Mayor Pro Tem Darst arrived at 6:32 PM.

NEW BUSINESS

Discuss and take possible action on a resolution to amend Resolution No. 2020-023(R).

Mayor Thornton called upon Ms. Sonya Herrera, Asst City Attorney. Ms. Herrera briefed the City Council on Res. 2020-23(R). She explained that a clerical error was made on the dates within Res. No. 2020-23(R), and that Mayor Thornton vetoed the Resolution. Presented to the City Council was a new Resolution, No. 2020-25(R), that recognized the Mayor's veto and duplicated the provisions of Res. No 2020-23(R) with the corrected dates.

MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCIL MEMBER SKAGGS TO ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2020-25(R) ACKNOWLEDGING THE MAYOR'S VETO OF RESOLUTION NO. 2020-23(R) AND CLARIFYING THE POSITION OF CITY SECRETARY IN WHICH THE CITY COUNCIL DETERMINES IT CURRENTLY LACKS CONFIDENCE THAT SHANNON KINSLEY CAN PERFORM THE DUTIES OF CITY SECRETARY IN THE MANNERS PERFERRED AND EXPECTED BY CITY COUNCIL. MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCIL MEMBER POSS.

THE MAYOR CALLED FOR A RECORDED VOTED: MAYOR PRO TEM DARST, YEA; COUNCIL MEMBER NOTTINGHAM, YEA; COUNCIL MEMBER POSS YEA; COUNCIL MEMBER VERITY, YEA; AND COUNCIL MEMBER SKAGGS, YEA. MOTION PASSED 5-0.

Discuss and take possible action on the Mayor's Advisory Road Committee's ("MARC") presentation to city council on a plan for road repairs for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

The Mayor's Advisory Road Committee made a presentation to the City Council with recommendations, but no action was taken.


