

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-004

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF GREY FOREST, TEXAS FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 BUDGET BY TRANSFERING FUNDS FROM THE "CITY GREEN SPACE" BUDGET LINE ITEM TO THE SENATOR FRANK L. MADLA PARK BUDGET LINE ITEM.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grey Forest approved the budget for the 2020-2021 fiscal year on September 28, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the "City Green Space" budget line item currently reflects funds that are used for green space purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Green Space line item is also a restricted line item in the City's budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 that requires approval by City Council before any funds can be transferred; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to transfer funds from the City Green Space line item to the Madla Park Operations (Carryover Estimated) line item, which will result in an increase to the amount currently budgeted for the Madla Park Operations (Carryover Estimated) line item; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that transferring funds from the City Green Space line item to the Madla Park Operations (Carryover Estimated) line item supports efforts to preserve and maintain green spaces and natural areas.

I.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREY FOREST, TEXAS that the City Council of the City of Grey Forest approves amending the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year budget to transfer \$1,278.00 from line item 1100 City Green Space Restricted to line item MADLA PARK OPERATIONS (Carryover Estimated). Said transfer will increase the MADLA PARK OPERATIONS (Carryover Estimated) line item from \$2,816.00 to \$4,094.00.

II.

CUMULATIVE CLAUSE

That this Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of the City of Grey Forest, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such other ordinance, in which event the conflicting provisions of such other ordinance are hereby repealed, while leaving the remainder of such other ordinance intact. To the extent of any conflict, this Ordinance is controlling.

III.
SEVERABILITY


That it is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Grey Forest. that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance should be declared unconstitutional or invalid by final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of the Ordinances, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid phrases, sentences, paragraphs, or sections.

IV.
PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government




