

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-08

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREY FOREST, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE 200; ARTICLE 2.01 GENERAL PROVISIONS; SEC 2.01.001 DEFINITIONS, "RESTRAINT"; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; REPEALING ALL PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the City of Grey Forest, Texas, is a Type A general-law municipality located in Bexar County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted regulations concerning animal control in the City, codified as Chapter 2 "Animal Control" in the Grey Forest Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary and advisable to amend portions of the existing animal control regulations regarding the restraint of animals in the City and clarifying the definition of restraint in order to promote public health and safety and the general welfare of the citizens of the City.

I.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CITY OF GREY FOREST, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: Findings. The recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2: Amendments to Chapter 2. Chapter 2 ("Animal Control") Section 2.01.001 Definitions, animals at large, shall be amended, to include the addition of "physical" and "lead attached to an animal collar or harness" and strike "or otherwise under the control of a responsible person and obedient to that person's commands" to read as follows:

Restraint. Any animal secured by a physical leash or lead attached to an animal collar or harness ~~otherwise under the control of a responsible person and obedient to that person's commands.~~ At all other times, a dog or other animal shall be confined to the realty or premises of the owner of such dog or other animal by a substantial fence of sufficient strength and height to prevent such dog or other animal from escaping therefrom; or inside a house on such premises; or secured on such premises by a leash consisting of a material of sufficient strength to prevent said dog or other animal from escaping such premises. It shall be unlawful for the leash to be arranged in a manner that allows the dog or other animal to get on or across any street, park, or other public land. Any animal so arranged shall be considered dangerous to the public in general and declared a nuisance, and shall be impounded.

SECTION 3. All remaining provisions of Chapter 2 (Animal Control) Section 2.01.001 shall remain unchanged except for the amendment to add and delete outlined in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. Conflicting Ordinances or Resolutions. All resolutions or ordinances or parts thereof conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance as adopted and amended herein, are hereby **REPEALED** to the extent of such conflict. In the event of a conflict or inconsistency between this ordinance and another resolution, code or ordinance of the City, or parts thereof, the term and provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

**II.
CUMULATIVE CLAUSE**

That this Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of the City of Grey Forest except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such Ordinance, in which event the conflicting provisions of such Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**III.
SEVERABILITY**

That it is hereby declared to be the intent of the City Council of the City of Grey Forest that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance should be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of the Ordinances, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrases, sentences, paragraphs, or sections.




