

**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-11-31**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GREY FOREST, TX, CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT WITH TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES (TAC) COUNTY INFORMATION RESOURCES AGENCY (CIRA) TO BECOME A MEMBER AND PARTICIPATE IN THE CENTRAL, COOPERATIVE AND COORDINATED ASSISTANCE AND SERVICES TO MEMBERS IN ALL MATTERS RELATING TO INFORMATION RESOURCES AND TECHNOLOGIES IN ORDER TO INCREASE EFFICIENCIES AND IMPROVE THE QUALITY, RELIABILITY AND INTEROPERABILITY OF INFORMATION RESOURCES, TECHNOLOGIES AND SERVICES AND PAY THE APPLICABLE MEMBERSHIP FEE; PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE CLAUSE, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Grey Forest is a Type A general-law municipality located in Bexar County, created in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, modern technologies and telecommunication systems offer tremendous opportunities to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of government in Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, Texas Association of Counties (TAC) County Information Resources Agency (CIRA) provides more effective, efficient and reliable public services due to Texas counties and other local governments working with one another, the State and the private sector to build and maintain technology and communication systems; and

**WHEREAS**, several counties have joined together by interlocal agreement to create CIRA to administer their collective efforts concerning information and technology; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Grey Forest finds it in the best interest of the community to enter into said Interlocal Participation Agreement with TAC CIRA to increase the efficiency of the City's information technology and communication systems.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREY FOREST, TEXAS that**

Section 1. Findings. The recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign an Interlocal Participation Agreement with Texas Association of Counties (TAC) County Information Resources Agency (CIRA) to become a Member and participate in the central, cooperative and coordinated assistance and

services to Members in all matters relating to information resources and technologies in order to increase efficiencies and improve the quality, reliability and interoperability of information resources, technologies and services and pay the applicable membership fee.

**II.  
CUMULATIVE CLAUSE**

That this Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of the City of Grey Forest, except where the provisions of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such other ordinance, in which event the conflicting provisions of such other ordinance are hereby repealed, while leaving the remainder of such other ordinance intact. To the extent of any conflict, this Ordinance is controlling.

**III.  
SEVERABILITY**

That it is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Grey Forest. that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance should be declared unconstitutional or invalid by final judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections of the Ordinances, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid phrases, sentences, paragraphs, or sections.

**IV.  
PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING**

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government

**V.  
EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by state and local law.

**DULY PASSED AND APPROVED**, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2022 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Grey Forest, Texas, which was held in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, Gov't. Code §551.001, et. Seq. at which meeting a quorum was present and voting.


